
Hirosaki Park boasts the sole remaining Edo-period castle keep of its kind north of Japan's Kanto region. The area is now a park, well-loved by the locals. The park is populated with about 2,600 cherry trees, mostly of the someiyoshino variety. The western moat is especially striking, with trees lining both sides to create an arch-like effect. Visitors can enjoy the cherry blossoms from within the arch by boat. The park is also home to the oldest someiyoshino trees in all of Japan.
